





<p>Writing and Grammar</p> 	<p>Genre: Narrative</p> <p>We will be learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be reading <i>Who Let the Gods Out</i>. • Using a range of descriptive vocabulary to engage the reader. • Using compound and complex sentences to develop descriptions in our writing. • In grammar we will be revisiting skills we learnt last year to ensure that they are secure (Punctuation, word classes, sentence types).
<p>Reading and Spelling</p> 	<p>We will be...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a range of stories and where possible these will be linked to our History unit which is <i>The Ancient Greeks</i>. • We will be focussing on the book <i>Who Let the Gods Out</i>. • Using our knowledge of reading strategies to work out the meaning of unknown words. • Retrieving the answers to who, what, where, when and how questions by looking in the text. • Making inferences from the text.
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>Focus: Place Value</p> <p>We are learning...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to read and write numbers with five or more digits • The value of each digit in numbers • Negative Numbers • Roman Numerals • Addition and subtraction of 4 digit numbers
<p>Science</p> 	<p>Topic: Chemistry – Properties and Changes of Materials</p> <p>We will be learning how to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal), and response to magnets. • use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.

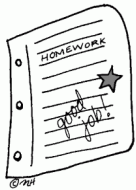
Your child will be developing their physical skills through:
