Homework:

Homework is set every Friday and needs to be handed in by the following Monday. Children in Year 1 will be getting a list of spellings, which they will need to practise at home.



Reading:

Your child gets a Guided Reading book once a week. In order to take a new book home, your child will need to bring this book to school in their school book bag every day. Please encourage your child to read daily for 10 minutes with the support of an adult. Also, please ensure that your child remembers to bring in their Guided Reading book each week.

Literacy:

During the beginning of this term, we will be focusing on Narrative writing. Children will be exploring the features of fiction texts and will be looking closely at the features of fantasy stories. Subsequently, using our enquiry question 'How has flight made our lives better?' and key features, they will be writing their own fantasy stories. At home, please encourage your child to write sentences/stories using their phonic knowledge, capital letters, finger spaces, adjectives and full stops.



PE:

We have PE sessions every Tuesday so, it is vital that your child comes in their PE kit in school on this day. Your child's P.E kit should contain:

- School house P.E. T-shirt (not football shirts or any other sporting t-shirt/hoody).
- Black shorts/jogging bottoms (close fitting leggings may be worn by girls).
- Plimsolls or trainers.

Humanities

In Geography, children will be carrying out simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds. Furthermore, they will be carrying out simple fieldwork of the key human and physical features of the surrounding environment.

Design & Technology

Children will understand that different mechanisms produce different types of movements, e.g. wheels, sliders, levers and hinges. They will explore and use simple mechanisms. For example, they will use sliders in moving pictures.
